

OAK HARBOR MARINA RULES

The following rules apply to all who own or rent a slip at Oak Harbor Marina as well as their guests. These rules do not take the place of common sense and courtesy.

1. No boat shall be refueled in the Marina.
2. Boardwalks (Head Docks) must be kept clear of obstructions including grills, strollers, chairs, etc. This includes overhang of bow pulpits.
3. Cooking fires are allowed only in devices that contain the fire and any waste material from the fire or cooking is to be cleaned up and disposed of properly.
4. Fireworks are prohibited in the Marina. Fallout can cause serious damage to very expensive canvas and finishes.
5. Glass containers are NOT allowed in the pool or bathroom areas.
6. The bathrooms are to remain locked at ALL times.
7. Swimming or diving from the docks or boats in the Marina is prohibited.
8. Bicycles are not allowed on the boardwalks. A bicycle rack is provided.
9. All garbage, including fish cleaning waste, must be secured in plastic bags and placed in the Dumpster that is provided.
10. Carpet may not be attached to docks or pilings.
11. Bathroom facilities are the most widely used common areas. Good sanitation practices are required, courtesy to the next user is expected.
12. Laundry is not to be hung on docks, pilings, or posts.
13. Lines running down sailboat masts are to be tied off securely to prevent excessive noise.
14. Parking on the inside perimeter of the paved lot is limited to one vehicle per slip. Additional cars and guests are to park in the paved area long side of road or in the field across the street. Overnight parking of RV's in the parking lot is prohibited.
15. The launching of boats, jet skies, etc. from trailers is prohibited anywhere in the Marina.
16. Young children are to be accompanied by responsible adult in the pool area, the bathrooms and all other common areas of the Marina. Proper behavior of children is the responsibility of the parent or accompanying adult. The Marina facilities and equipment are not to be used as a playground.
17. Pets are to be on a leash (6' or shorter) and under the control of an individual capable of handling the pet whenever in a common area of the Marina. Pets are expected to use the field across the street. Pet owners are expected to remove and properly dispose of all pet waste which might occur in the Marina proper. Pets are NOT allowed in the pool or bathroom areas.
18. Courtesy to fellow boaters is expected. Tastes in music (volume or content), language, and sense of humor are individual things and privacy of others is to be respected.
